What is the AMM e-training platform, and workplace-based assessments

Following the successful completion of the houseman internship, an inspired trainee may wish to pursue a surgical career in Malaysia, by enrolling in the Basic Surgical Training (BST) program. This allows the trainee to be registered with the Academy of Medicine (AMM), College of Surgeons, and the use of the AMM e-Training Platform (ETP) in the BST. Similarly, an inspired qualified specialist surgeon may wish to advance in training the junior surgeons by registering with the AMM as the trainer. The web-based ETP has been developed and implemented as the instrument by the AMM to aid surgical trainer/trainee in the organization and collection of all training experience and evidence, assessments and feedback, e-portfolio alike.

The fundamental change in surgical education has been a shift away from a traditional apprenticeship to structured training with associated assessment tools, for which the workplace-based assessments (WBAs) have been chosen to assess a trainee's day-to-day performance in normal work and provide constructive feedback.
