Workplace-Based Assessment and e-Portfolio System for Surgical Training

Postgraduate surgical training has been the subject of many changes over the last decades worldwide. Contemporary postgraduate surgical training is characterised by clear objectives and outcomes for the profession, hand in hand with an assessment system. Surgical trainees need to be assessed on a continuous and frequent basis, using Workplace-Based Assessment (WBA) tools that provide quality and qualitative approaches, such as narrative feedback for actual day-to-day performance in normal work.

The tool used to collect assessment and feedback instruments is the portfolio, nowadays used in many countries worldwide because it fulfills performance-based and evidence-based obligation. The organisation and collection of all assessment and feedback is quite an undertaking, for which the electronic portfolio seems to be the most obvious tool.

These webinars will discuss the Basic Surgical Training Curriculum and our newly developed web-based WBA tools with e-portfolio system, which would be officially launched for basic surgical trainees and surgical trainers in Malaysia.
